WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

- INDOT's project priorities and the revised process to achieve them.
- Preview of the performance specs to maximize innovation.
- Overview of the Alternative Technical Concepts (ATC) process.
- Process to develop the construction schedule.

PROJECT DETAILS:

- Up to 13 miles of roadway improvements in Clark and Scott Counties, with a focus on added travel lanes (ATL) and pavement reconstruction.
- Includes superstructure and widening work on at least 4 bridges along I-65, and desirably more widening and rehab work on 5 more bridges.
- Roadway rehabilitation work wherever ATL is infeasible.
- Fixed price fee of \$203.7 million.
- Proposers will identify which improvements they will include in the variable scope, supplementing base bid elements.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS:

It is anticipated that INDOT will utilize a two-step procurement process, including the submission of a Statement of Qualifications, which will be used to develop a shortlist of qualified Proposers followed by a Request for Proposals (RFP).
